

Booties for Cancer Patients

If you have the time, The Biggest Morning Tea and Peter Mac Callum are asking for your help.

Funky Feet - 3 balls of feathers will make 2 pairs

Materials - 2 x 50 gram balls of feather wool
1 x 100 grams 8 ply acrylic or 2 x 50 gram balls
6 mm needles

Cast on 37 stitches with 8 ply sole wool using 2 strands.

1st Row *Inc. in 1st stitch knit 16 inc in next stitch. Repeat from * once Knit 1.
2nd 4th & 6th rows Purl
3rd Row *Inc in 1st stitch Knit 18 inc. in next stitch Repeat from * once Knit 1.
5th Row *Inc in 1st stitch Knit 20 inc. in next stitch Repeat from * once Knit 1.
7th Row *Inc in 1st stitch Knit 22 inc. in next stitch Repeat from * once Knit 1.
8th Row Knit.
9th Row Purl.
10th Row Knit.

Change to one strand feathers one strand 8 ply
Work 8 rows in st. stitch beginning with a knit row

Shape instep

1st Row K.31 slip 1 knit pss. Turn
2nd Row K.10 P2 tog. Turn
3rd Row K.10 slip 1 K 1 pss. Turn

Repeat Rows 2 & 3 7 times and 2nd Row once.
Next row Knit to end of row (35 stitches)
Next row Purl. Make 1 extra st (36)

Change to smaller needles

Work 18 rows in double Rib (K2 P2)
(16 Rows for shorter boots - 20 Rows for longer boots.)
Break off feathers and join in other strand of 8 ply wool
Next 2 rows Knit
Next 2 rows Purl
Cast off Knitwise.

Join sole seam as a flat seam and backstitch or oversew leg seam using 8 ply.

Patter for all sizes varied by thickness of wool and size of needles.
(knitted as printed will fit a ladies size 7 to 8 approx) Using number 8 imperial needles and same ply wool will make a pair that will fit a 3 to 4 year old.

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
