

Marsupial Pouches

If you can sew or knit we can use your help.
We are always in need of pouches of assorted sizes.

Considerations

Please round the corners of sewn pouches as small animals may bury into the corners and can suffocate. All seams should be on the outside or French seamed and any loose threads removed. Ease of washing should be considered and also shrinkage of wool.

Specifications

Small pouches 10cm x 15cm
Medium pouches 15cm x 20cm
Large pouches 20cm x 30cm
Jumbo pouches 45cm x 55cm

Fabric Pouches sewn 3 sides with top open

Preferred materials are:

Polar fleece
Windcheater fleecy
Cotton
Flannelette

Flannelette Pouches are used as pouch liners helping to increase the life span of the pouch.

Knitted pouches

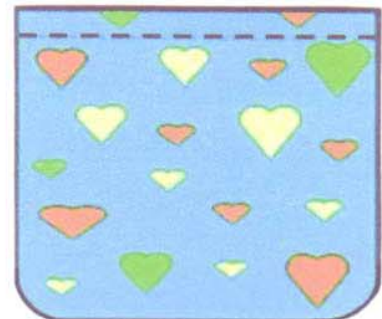
Can be made with any wool blends
